Slovenian lawyer Roman Završek elected 2026 President of the CCBE

Following his election at the Plenary Session of the Council of Bars and Law Societies of Europe (CCBE) on 27 November 2025, **Roman Završek officially assumed the position of CCBE President on 1 January 2026.**

Roman Završek, founder and Managing Partner of law firm Završek & Šnajder L.L.C., is also the founder of the association Adria Legal Group. He graduated from the Faculty of Law at the University of Ljubljana in 1997, specialising in civil and commercial law, as well as human rights law.

He has undertaken numerous roles within the Slovenian Bar Association, ultimately serving as its President from 2012 to 2021. His involvement with the CCBE spans many years, having become Head of the CCBE Slovenian delegation in 2012.

He also chaired the CCBE Platform for Exchange, Cooperation and Outreach (PECO) Committee from June 2020 to January 2023.

His presidency will be supported by Alex Tallon (Belgium) as first Vice-President, Imbi Jürgen (Estonia) as second Vice-President, and Noemí Alarcón Velasco (Spain) as third Vice-President.
